

BOAT COVER USE AND CARE



SNAP COVERS

- Be certain to use all snaps.
- Poles should be pushed up tight to hold cover tight for travel.
- During or after first trip check all snaps. Usually if there is a problem it is at the rear of the boat. We typically can remedy any problem with other types of fasteners. Do not let a cover wind whip which will cause damage to your boat and cover.
- We suggest a product called Snap Lube if the snaps become difficult to unsnap. This product is available at our location.

TIE DOWN COVERS

- Rope should be cinched first, then attach tie downs.
- Use all tie downs – stretch tight.
- Poles should be pushed up tight to hold cover tight for travel.
- Take note how and where the tie downs are attached to the trailer. It is best to use the same tension and same locations each time.
- Canvas Craft cannot assume responsibility of rub marks from bungies/tie downs.

CLEANING & CARE

- Prevent water from pooling on cover for long periods when being stored.
- Do not store your boat wet or allow water to stand inside your boat as moisture will be trapped inside and mold/mildew can grow on your cover/upholstery and other areas of your boat.
- Vents in covers will help cover to breath but will not **“DRY-OUT”** the inside of your boat.
- Clean – using a mild soap (like dish detergent) and water solution with a wash mitt, rinse and allow to dry. We have cleaners available for this purpose at our location.
- Do not roll up and store cover when damp or wet. Mold/Mildew can grow on fabric and be difficult to remove from your cover or upholstery.
- Always replace & repair your cover promptly if damage occurs.

WARRANTY

- Boat covers and boat tops carry a two year workmanship warranty.
- Fabrics may carry an additional manufacturer’s warranty.
- Boat covers must be properly secured for travel using all tie downs or snaps. Tops are to be secured for use on water at a maximum speed of 25 mph. Tops & Enclosures are not intended for road travel.
- Warranty does not cover rubbing, wear marks, mold/mildew on boat, motor or upholstery.
- This warranty does not cover damages due to misuse, negligence, vandalism, or acts of nature, including but not limited to wind, hail, lightning, rain, or snow.
